	16:09			Mr. DZIEKANSKI was cleared through the Primary Inspection Line lane #10 by BSO A and referred to secondary for further processing.
	16:09 to 19:00	171 min 2 h, 51 m	220 min 3 h, 40 m	The whereabouts of Mr. DZIEKANSKI are unaccounted for during this time period. Security camera positioning and view obstruction due to construction in the area prevented full optical coverage of the area.
	Approx. 19:00			BSO B working in immigration secondary received an inquiry on the dedicated phone line that provides the public a phone link, via a wall phone outside the Immigration front office. The male advised he and his wife had been at the airport for five hours waiting for his wife's son, a Polish male, seeking entry as a new immigrant. BSO B visually checked the immigration secondary area and verified the names of the people being detained. She advised the caller she did not find anyone who matched the description. She confirmed with the caller that the traveller had his mother's cell phone

				number. The caller advised the BSO that they would be returning to their home in Kamloops.

	21:25			Mr. DZIEKANSKI is seen on security recording to be walking in the CBSA Hall on the west end of baggage carousel 23.
	21:25 to 21:31	6 min	371 min 6 h, 11 m	The whereabouts of Mr. DZIEKANSKI are unaccounted for during this time period.
	21:31			Mr. DZIEKANSKI is seen on security recording to be walking in the CBSA Hall on the west end of baggage carousel 23.
	21:31 to 22:35	64 min	435 min 7 h, 15 m	The whereabouts of Mr. DZIEKANSKI are unaccounted for during this time period.
	22:35 to 22:44	9 min	444 min 7 h, 24 m	Mr. DZIEKANSKI approached the CBSA Hall exit and was directed to customs secondary. BSO C examined Mr. DZIEKANSKI'S passport and noted an Immigrant Visa affixed to the passport, which had not yet been processed. BSO C inspected Mr. DZIEKANSKI'S luggage trying to locate the remainder of his immigration documentation. However the additional documentation was not present.
	22:44 to 22:51	7 min	451 min 7h, 31 m	BSO'S C and D escort Mr. DZIEKANSKI to immigration secondary after completing his customs examination.

BSO C then proceeded to the Lufthansa baggage counter and found two additional checked-in pieces of luggage belonging to Mr. DZIEKANSKI. BSO C delivered the baggage to the immigration secondary area.

	23:15 to 23:40	25 min	500 min 8 h, 20 m	BSO E noticed Mr. DZIEKANSKI sitting in the immigration secondary area. BSO B advised BSO E she had spoken to Mr. DZIEKANSKI'S reception earlier in the evening and they may have returned to Kamloops. BSO'S E and F find Mr. DZIEKANSKI'S remaining immigration documents in one of the two recovered check-in bags and begin Mr. DZIEKANSKI'S immigration processing. BSO E paged for his reception twice over the International Arrivals public address system. BSO E obtains the local telephone number for Mr. DZIEKANSKI'S family.
	23:40 to 24:00	20 min	520 min 8 h, 40 m	BSO E makes a telephone call to Mr. DZIEKANSKI'S family to confirm information and left a message to call her back. There was no response to the pages or phone calls. The BSO also walked to the public area to see if his relatives might be there. On her return she inquired with the CBSA front reception as to whether anyone had been looking for a Polish immigrant. The answer was negative.

	00:00 00:15	15 min	535 min 8 h, 55 m	BSO G was requested to assist with Mr. DZIEKANSKI'S processing as he has some limited knowledge of the Polish language. BSO E completes Mr. DZIEKANSKI'S immigration process and releases him.
	00:15 00:39	24 min	559 min 9 h, 19 m	BSO G discovers Mr. DZIEKANSKI had resumed sitting in the immigration secondary area and advises him a second time that he was free to leave.
	00:39 00:45	6 min	565 min 9 h, 25 m	Mr. DZIEKANSKI was escorted by BSO G to the customs secondary area and was released.
	00:46	1 min	566 min 9 h, 26 m	Mr. DZIEKANSKI exits the secondary area and walks towards the exit in the International Reception Lounge (IRL) of YVR.

	02:10			<p>BSO G answers a call from a woman who identifies herself as the mother of <i>Robert from Poland</i> who was immigrating today. He advised her that her son did arrive and he had not come down to customs and immigration until recently. He further advised her that he had helped him and that he would look for him on his way out from his shift. BSO G was unaware at that time of the events involving Mr. DZIEKANSKI and the RCMP and told her he would bring Mr. DZIEKANSKI into the immigration office to call her if he found him. He took her name and phone number. He learned of the events when he left the office and spoke with an RCMP member.</p>
